As part of our Science topic on adaptation, inheritance and evolution, Year 6 are going to embark on an educational visit to Blue Planet Aquarium. During our visit the children will take part in workshops to see how sea creatures have adapted over many years.

The visit will take place on **Thursday 2nd March** and we will be leaving school promptly at **8.30am** (Children be on the yard for **8.15am**). We anticipate arriving back at school at **4.00pm**. All children will need to be in full school uniform.

During our visit, there may be an opportunity to visit the shop. If you wish to provide your child with spending money, please ensure they have **no more than £5**, and that their money is brought in a labelled envelope or purse/wallet.

If your child usually has a school dinner then a packed lunch will automatically be provided for them unless you let us know beforehand using the slip below. Therefore, if you pay for school dinners please send the normal amount of £11.50 at the beginning of the week.

The school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be **£6 per half term** or **£36.00 for the whole year**.

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.
