Breakfast Club and After School Club

Dear Parents and Carers,

Moorpark is committed to providing opportunities for working parents, and those seeking to develop themselves through training and further education, by providing high quality care before school. From the feedback we have received from families in the November, 2016, survey, we have recognised that you need us to provide an earlier opening of the breakfast club and if this is a success we will be working towards providing an after school care club for working families too.

The Governors of Moorpark have reviewed their current provision and have agreed to make some immediate changes as detailed below:

As of the **9th January, 2017** Breakfast Club will now open at **7.30 am until 8.50 am**. All children will be provided with a breakfast and supervision until school opens at 8.50am.

The cost of this will be **increased to £3 per child, per day** (previously this has been £2.00 but from an 8.00 am opening). We have carefully considered the fee and we believe that £3.00 is a very fair and competitive charge for before school care. Furthermore, we have not increased our charges since 2012 and we have always aimed to run the service as a non-profit making venture that covers staffing and food. However, as we all unfortunately know, overall costs have risen across widespread services and supplies over the last four years, therefore the increased fee also ensures continued provision on a non-profit basis. We hope you agree that Moorpark's Breakfast Club still offers excellent value for pre-school child care.

If your child attends and wishes not to have any breakfast you must still pay the £3.00 daily fee. This is due to us providing a child care service for your child until the school day begins at 8.50am. Regardless of what time you bring your child to the breakfast club the charge is set at £3.00 flat rate.

For those parents who have not used this facility in the past, I have included some details below:

Breakfast Club starts will start at 7.30 am until 8.50 am every day.
Children are welcome to attend on an 'ad hoc' basis and do not have to attend every day.
Children bring the money with them to Breakfast Club and pay daily.
There are a variety of activities on offer for the children after they have enjoyed their breakfast.

In order to attend breakfast club you must complete a registration form, which you can detail any food allergies that your child may have.

As previously mentioned, we also acknowledge that parents/carers would like us to provide an After School Care Club, we will update you on this accordingly.
