



Dear Parent/ Carer,

Year 6 will be visiting Alton Towers on **Friday, 29th June**, as a reward for their hard work and as a celebration of their final year at Moorpark Juniors. In order to be able to go to Alton Towers, Year Six understand that they **can only lose 9 stamps** and have been working on this since 16th April 2018. To ensure they do not lose a stamp each day, the children must demonstrate excellent behaviour and high standards of school uniform (including black school shoes, not trainers). If your child has lost 5 stamps the school will contact you at the earliest opportunity, to discuss how your child can change their behaviour to avoid missing out on the visit.

The children will be able to wear tracksuit bottoms and trainers, but must wear their school t-shirt/jumper.

There are opportunities for the children to spend money. It is up to your own discretion as to how much money your child brings. Any cash brought will be the personal responsibility of the child.

We will be leaving school promptly at **8.30am**. **Children must arrive on the yard for 8:15am to be registered before we leave**. We anticipate arriving back at school at approximately **6.15 pm**.

If your child requires a packed lunch from school please indicate on the form below. Therefore, if you pay for school dinners please ensure that you pay the usual £2.30 a meal onto your child's account or alternatively pay £11.50 for the week via Parentpay.

The school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be **£7 per half term** or **£42.00 for the whole year**. The trip will also need to be paid for via Parentpay. If you would prefer to pay via Paypoint then please take the barcode at the bottom of this letter to your nearest outlet to make the payment.

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.

We cannot accept verbal permission therefore if you do not return the form below your child will not be able to attend the visit.
