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Dear Parents/ Carers,

We are delighted to announce the dates for the 2017, Year 6, Stanley Head Outdoor Education residential.

**Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> December – Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2017.**

The children will have the opportunity to embark on a fun- filled week of team building activities that will provide them with invaluable life skills such as resilience, co-operation and independence. The arranged programme will provide a mix of activities including climbing, rafting or canoeing, high ropes, archery, map skills expeditions and much more. During their stay, the children will be sleeping in dormitories. We know that this experience will have a positive impact on the children's progress and wellbeing.

The cost to school for the week is £135 per child, however, the governors want all children to gain from this valuable experience and have therefore planned to maintain the subsidy from school to reduce the cost of the week to you even more this year. Therefore, the parental contribution for this year is £60.00. If you are in receipt of free school meals, or have been at any point in the last six years and your child receives the Pupil Premium it further reduces the cost to £30.00. *(If you think that you may be entitled to free school meals please ask the school office for an application form, we will ensure that you know if your child is already eligible).*

Please confirm that your child will be joining this activity by signing and returning the permission slip below by **Monday, 8<sup>th</sup>, May** with a **£20.00 deposit** to secure your child's place.

This activity is extra to the topic educational visits that your child takes part in each half term. We hope you will benefit from the advance notice, so that you can spread the cost over the next 6 months. Payments may be made in instalments and the visit must be fully paid by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November.

A drop in session for parents will be arranged closer to the event in the Autumn term so that we can answer any initial queries you may have. We will notify you of this date in due course. A full consent and medical form is also required by the centre and must be returned to the school office (These will be supplied to you at the information session).
