Dear Parents/Carers,

Stoke-on-Trent City Council recognises that life is harder for families facing increased pressure on household budgets due to the cost of living crisis. This winter the Council has received grant funding from the Government Department of Work and Pensions to provide support to families with children, other vulnerable households and individuals.

As part of this programme of support the Council are providing vouchers for families of children attending schools in the city who have free school meals and families with children who have an Education and Health Care Plan in place.

Each eligible child in the family will receive a voucher for £40 for the Christmas break.

Before the end of term, you will receive a link directly from Schoolvouchers.com and you will be able to select an eVoucher from a supermarket on the list. You will be able to choose from Aldi, Asda, Iceland, Morrisons, Sainsburys, Tesco and Waitrose. The eVoucher code will be displayed on-screen and can be downloaded. The vouchers are issued directly from your chosen supermarket, please allow time for this to be allocated to you. If you have any queries in relation to your voucher allocation please contact your chosen supermarket. Vouchers should be issued on **Monday, 2nd December**.

If you do not have access to a phone or email, the School will be able to download your eVoucher and provide you with a printed copy.
