



Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our history topic on Anglo Saxons, Year 4 are going to embark on an educational visit to Tatton Park. During our visit the children will discover more about the life of Anglo Saxons.

The visit will take place on **Wednesday**, **25**th **September**, **2024** and we will be leaving school promptly at **8:45am** (Children to be on the yard for **08:30am**). We anticipate arriving back at school at **3:15pm**. We will be travelling by coach.

All children will need to be in full school uniform and wearing comfortable footwear. Please bring a coat as some of the activities will be outside.

Payment

Admission cost is £570 + Transport cost is £600 = The total cost of this trip to school is £1170 (Actual cost per child £19.50).

However, the school governors have agreed funding educational visits each half term and the cost of parental contributions will be £8 per half term to be paid for via ParentPay, therefore we are subsidising this trip by £11.50 per pupil.

As you can see school are heavily contributing towards the trip so if ALL parents do not pay the £8 contribution the trip will NOT be able to go ahead and will have to be cancelled.

Parental Consent **new system on parent pay*

To give permission for your child to go on this trip you will need to log on to ParentPay, find your child's account and the correct trip under payment items then follow the instructions ticking the relevant boxes. We cannot accept verbal permission therefore if you do not complete this your child will not be able to go on this trip.

If your child requires a packed lunch from school, please indicate when you pay for the trip on **ParentPay**. Please provide your child with a drink as one will not be provided with their lunch.

Please ensure that **any medication** that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and dosage requirements and that the teachers are aware that your child has the medication with them.
