

Stoke School Sport Partnerships presents: 'Reading is dreaming with eyes open - dance your dream' at The Victoria Hall, Stoke-on-Trent

We are excited to invite you to watch your child perform at The Victoria Hall, Hanley in Stoke School Sport Partnership's annual dance event taking place on **Tuesday**, **1**st **April**, **2025**.

Our school is one of 63 primary and secondary schools from across Stoke-on-Trent taking part and now in its 13th year this event brings together schools to showcase their inspirational dances. This year's theme is 'Reading is dreaming with eyes open – dance your dream'.

Tickets

A maximum of 2 tickets are available per performer at a cost of £10 each (under 18 months free but must sit on an adult's knee and have a 'babe in arms' ticket – this is also the policy of the venue).

Step Free Access and Wheelchairs

There are designated wheelchair and Step Free* access seats/spaces available within the theatre. Please inform the school if you use a wheelchair and need a wheelchair space or you require a Step Free access seat so that the correct ticket can be allocated to you.

*Step Free access seats are for audience members who would have difficulty walking up/down steps to their seats

How to order your tickets

Tickets can <u>only</u> be ordered from the school by the following deadline date: (**Thursday, 27**th **February, 2025**). Please, pay for tickets on ParentPay, details on how to pay is below. Complete and return the form at the bottom of this letter to the school by **Friday, 31st January for confirmation of attendance.**

Payments must be made on ParentPay, please look for the 'Tickets- Stoke SSP Dance Event 2025' payment item. If you would prefer to pay by cash (via a shop with PayPoint) please ask the school office to create a barcoded letter for this payment item. Be aware if we haven't received payment by Thursday, 27th February we will not be able to process your order. Only 2 tickets can be ordered, if additional tickets ever become available we will let you know via text once we have been notified from Stoke SSP, however this is not guaranteed and will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Please be aware if we can get additional tickets we cannot guarantee these will be seated with the initial order.

On the evening

Please bring your child to **The Victoria Hall** (Bagnall St, Hanley, Stoke-on-Trent ST1 3AD) on the night of the performance **between 5.30pm and 6pm** in their costume to the main foyer of the building. All performers will be seated in the stalls with their teachers, whilst parents/guardians with tickets will be seated in the circle and upper circle. Each school group will be allocated a meeting and collection point to meet their teacher on the night.

The performance will <u>start</u> at 6.30pm. We anticipate that the show would finish by approximately 8.00pm. If you are not watching the show, we ask that you arrive at Victoria Hall by no later than 7.45pm in readiness to collect your child from their teacher **once the show has finished** (you will not be able to collect your child before the end of the show).
